Award Nomination Process

- 1. A company, individual, organisation can apply for a maximum of three categories
- 2. All entries must be done carefully and as per the defined processes here
- 3. For each category, an entry must contain the following:
 - (a) A 200 word write up (Hindi or English) about the project highlighting its impact, both qualitative and quantitative. Special mention must be made, wherever applicable, about possible replication and scaling up of the model/intervention
 - (b) Two to three supporting photographs
 - (c) Wherever possible, upto three digital link of quality feature or social media posts
 - (d) Contact details including email id and phone number of the person whom additional queries could be addressed to. All four segments, clearly demarcated, should be converted into a single PDF and sent through an email to: info@thegreymatters.in
 - (e)Write Award Category in the Subject, and a small covering note of not more than 3 lines in the body of the mail.
 - (f) The shortlisted entries will be requested to have an interaction with the jury.




